What is Fervent Prayer

Definition

• Fervent: Having or displaying a passionate intensity (Oxford Languages Dictionary)

• Prayer: A solemn(formal and dignified) request for help or expression of thanks addressed to God or an object of worship. (Oxford Languages Dictionary)

• Effectual: Successful in producing a desired or intended result
